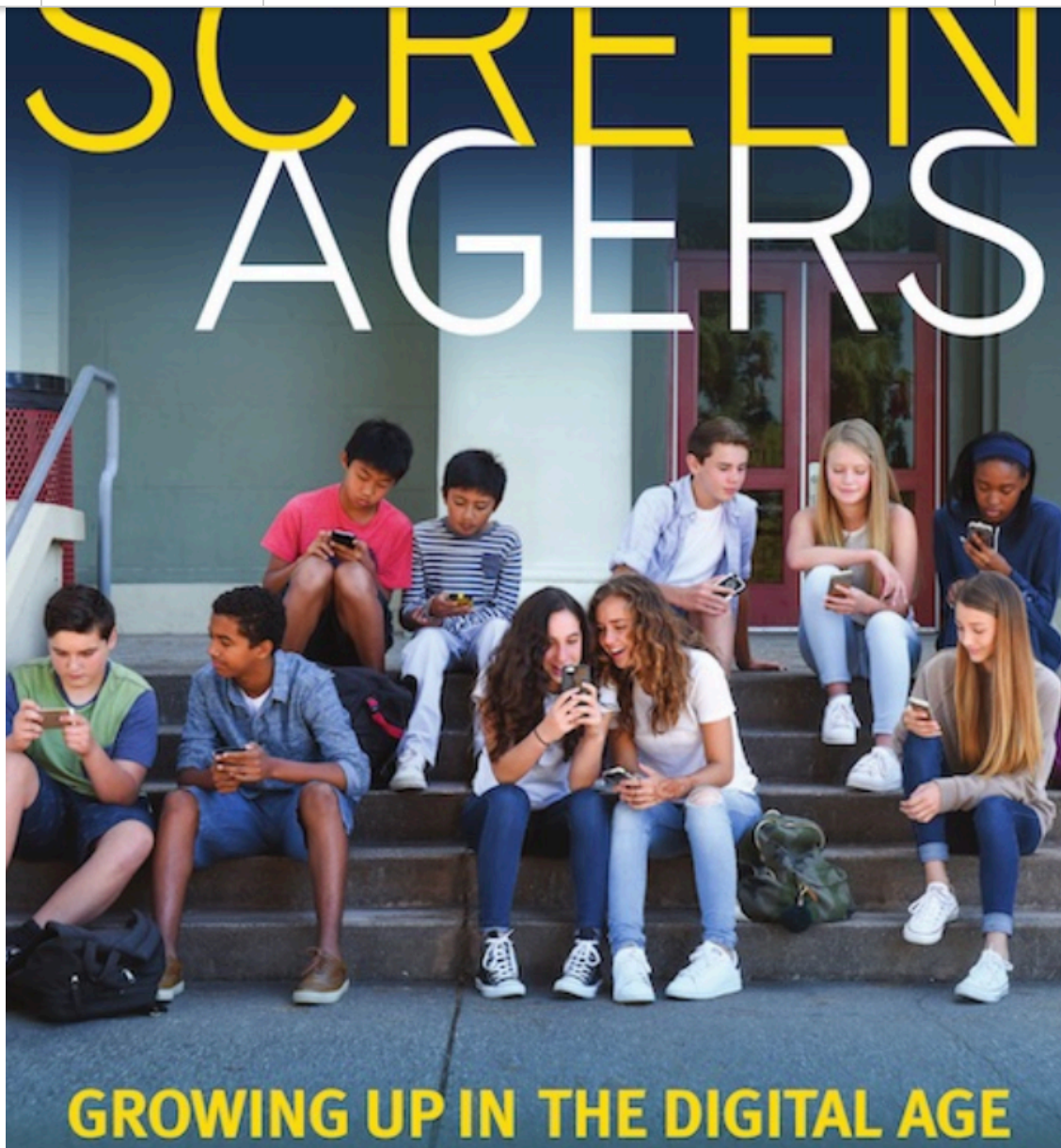

We focused on our Positive Behaviour Interventions and Supports (PBIS) work to support our goals of being **safe, kind, and responsible**. Students are seeing new posters around the school sharing ways to be safe in each area. We also highlighted each grade team's provincially funded new curriculum resources and how we can use them to support student achievement. Lastly, our new Cooper's Crossing Literacy Scope and Sequence was unveiled and discussed. This documents the sequence of outcomes from the new curriculum that students work towards related to word study/phonics, comprehension, and fluency as they learn to read. It was a valuable day of learning, all around. Thanks to parents for encouraging daily home reading to support students' literacy skills. Time spent with a child, a book, and an adult makes for great readers!

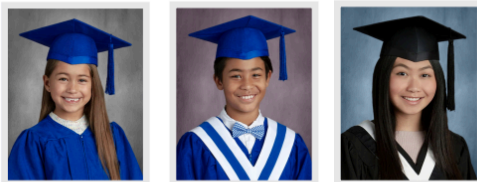

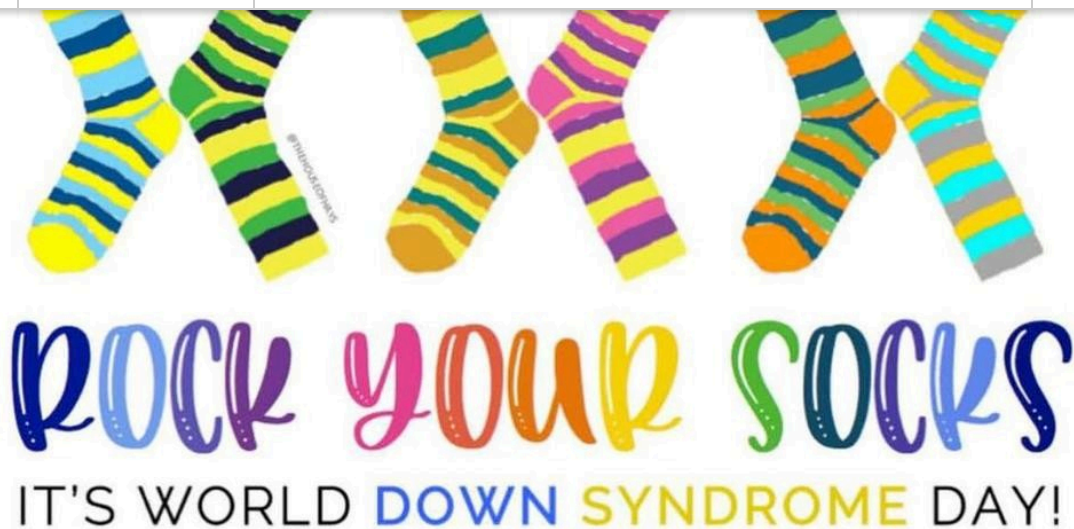

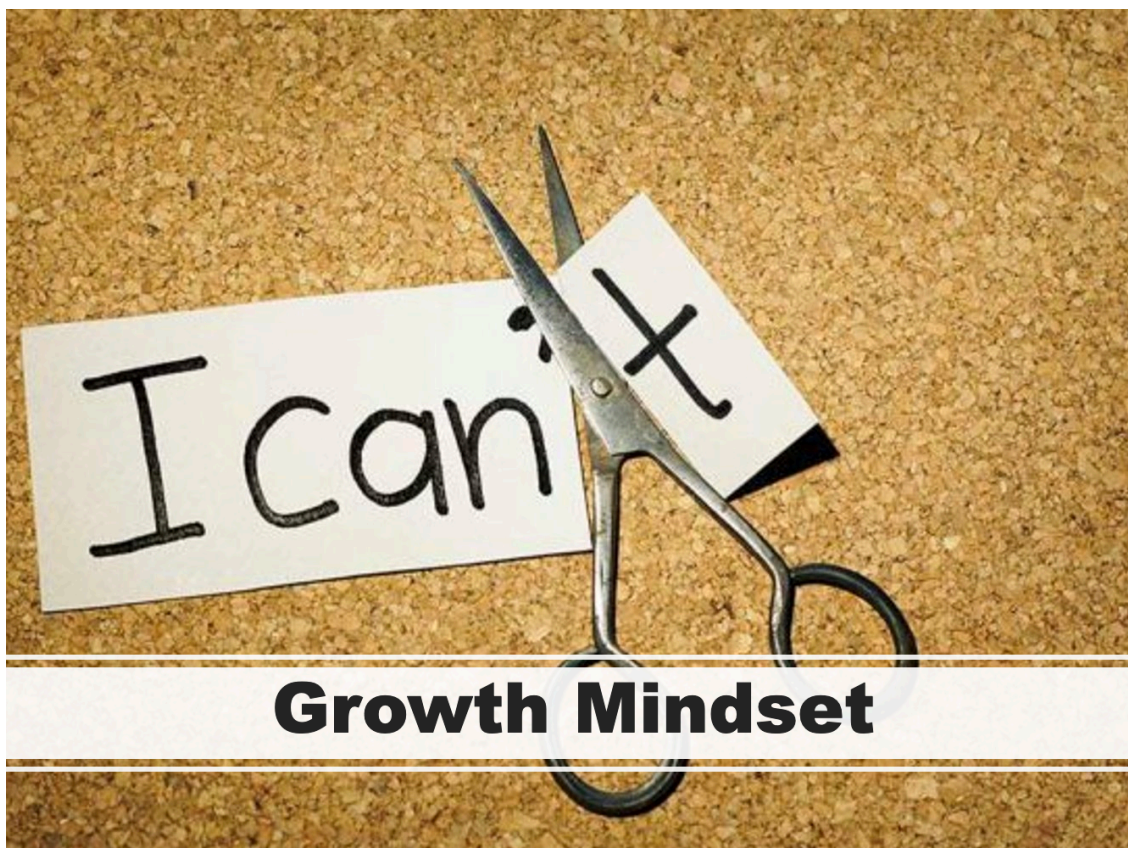
Scholastic Book Fair
