- March Board Meeting
 - 2022-2023 Set budget process and priorities: innovative programming and learning spaces, literacy and numeracy skill development, and boosting mental health and wellness for students
 - RVS growing by 750-1000 students - modular spaces not yet approved; Cochrane approved for new high school, Chestermere and Airdrie still waiting
- ASCA AGM April 24th -28th RVS supporting individuals to attend
- K-6 Curriculum – RVS is reviewing updated drafts
 - Social is back to drawing boards after controversy
- 59M for curriculum implementation across the province 2022/23
- 30M for student well-being across the province
